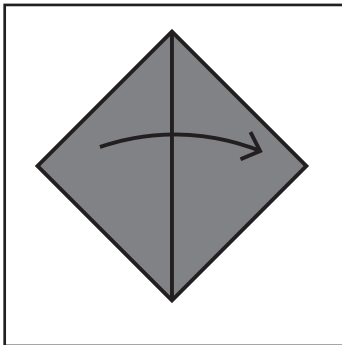

Here is a how to make an Origami Penguin.



YOU WILL NEED:

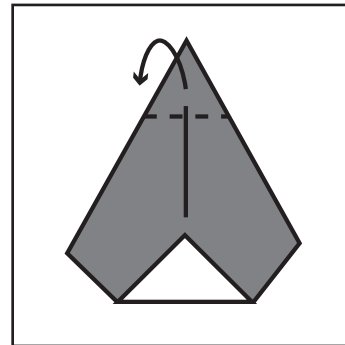
- A SQUARE PIECE OF PAPER
- COLOURING PENS OR CRAYONS



STEP 1

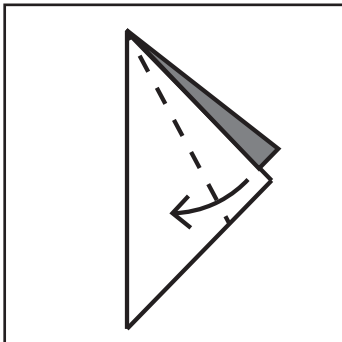
Before you start you can colour one or both sides of the paper.

Fold your square piece of paper in half.



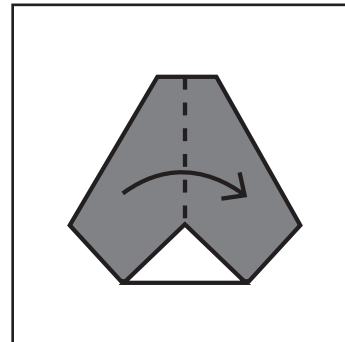
STEP 5

Fold another small triangle on the top of the kite shape - this time outwards, to the other side of the paper (where the wings are).



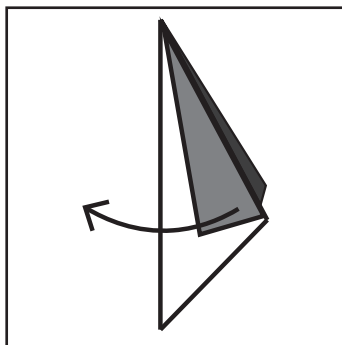
STEP 2

Fold a smaller triangle on one side - from the inside to the outside of your folded-in-half paper. This will be the wing.



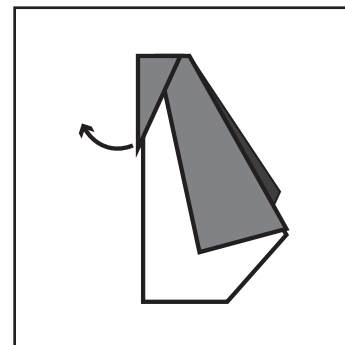
STEP 6

Fold the paper in back in half.



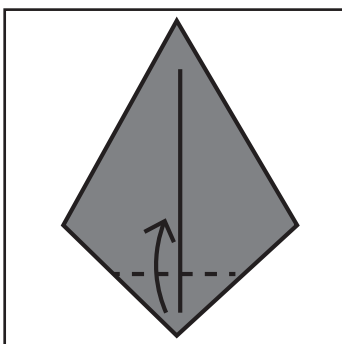
STEP 3

Repeat on the other side. This will be the second wing.



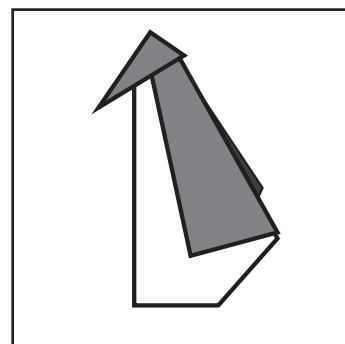
STEP 7

Now pull up the Penguins beak!



STEP 4

Open the paper with the wings laying on the other side. Fold a small triangle inwards from the bottom towards the top of the kite shape that you have.



STEP 8

Here is your finished Penguin!
